Ephesians 1:13–14, Romans 8:31–39

NOTES:

I. God's Grandeur

II. Look at the nature of Salvation and its implication on our lives.

1. Salvation = Born again (2 Corinthians 5:17)
2. Salvation = being redeemed (1 Peter 1:18–19)
3. Salvation = being justified (Romans 5:1)
4. Salvation = promised eternal life (John 3:16)
5. Salvation = being sealed by the Holy Spirit (Ephesians 1:13–14)
6. Salvation = guaranteed glorification (Romans 8:30)

III. What about Hebrews 6: 4-6?

What does this mean for us?

2. Have confidence!
3. Come to saving faith in Jesus Christ.
