Questions for Community Groups and Individual Bible Study:

1. Read John 1:1-5, 30. When you think of Jesus as being "greater" than you, what comes to mind? What are you thankful for about that? What is hard to grasp about that?
2. "Lamb of God"- Read Leviticus 4:35 and Hebrews 9:22. We are far removed from sacrificing animals in our culture. How can this concept be related to our current culture? How can we explain what this means to others?
3. Read John 3:16-17, Romans 10:9-13: Pretend (or maybe it is) your first time ever reading these verses. What strikes you? Why? What action needs to be taken by you individually after reading these?
4. Read Philippians 2:1-11: If you are a Christian and this is the challenge for all believers- how can you begin to serve and empty yourself? What does it look like?
