

**DISCOVERING LIFE TOGETHER SERIES: THE GOSPEL OF JOHN**  
**I AM ONE WITH THE FATHER — JOHN 10:22–42**  
**“The Deity of Christ”**

**John 10:22–30**

*Observations*

1. The works of Christ bear witness about His essence.
2. If you don't believe, you are not among Christ's sheep.
3. If you are one of Christ's sheep:
  - a. You hear His voice
    - *How do you know God is speaking to you?*
      - Conviction of sin in your life
      - *God revealing truth to you through the study of Scripture*
      - *You begin to glorify Christ*
  - b. Christ knows you (Psalm 139)
  - c. He gives His sheep eternal life (Romans 5:8–10)

*Application*

1. Christ's existence demands a response.
  - John 10:31–39
  - What is your response going to be?

**Questions for Community Groups or Individual Bible Study**

1. Are you one of Christ's sheep? If not, will you ask Him to save you? If yes, what are some ways you listen to His leading? How are you doing on following His voice? What are ways you can improve your “sheep listening skills”? Read Hebrews 12:6, Romans 12:1–2, 1 Corinthians 2:10, Psalm 119:160.
2. Read Psalm 139. What does this tell you about God's knowledge of you? What is your response to this?
3. Read John 10:27–29. Eternal security comes with being one of Christ's sheep. What does this mean to you? Have you ever wrestled with this truth? Why or why not?
4. The deity of Christ is of the utmost importance. Discuss this statement: *Jesus Christ Himself claimed deity. He taught His disciples to pray in His name. He claimed that He and the Father were one and that He was the Son of God. He claimed that to know Him was to know God, to see Him was to see God, to receive Him was to receive God, to believe Him was to believe in God, and to honor Him was to honor God, while to hate Him was to hate God.*
5. Scriptures to read/study: 2 Timothy 3:16–17, John 14:26, Romans 11:33, Romans 5:8–10, 1 John 5:20–21, Romans 8:26, John 14:17, 1 Corinthians 6:19.
